

## Sports Funding 2015

It is the intention to use the allocation of sports funding in the following ways:-

- Maintain and expand existing after school clubs
- Increase equipment that can be used at lunchtimes
- Invest in coaching to develop staff skill and to extend this to lunchtime sport leaders to ensure more sport happens over the lunch period
- Increase PE equipment throughout school for wider PE lessons
- Ensure that children can attend sporting events that may not have been possible by using the Sport Grant on transport to those events
- Invest in 'Bassetlaw Sports Package' to widen the opportunities for inter school sport workshops and competitions.
